**AIM OF COURSE**

Mandatory PJT for all RN officers and ratings before proceeding to sea for the first time.

OUTLINE SYLLABUS

Topics covered include:

- ◆ Firefighting organisation, equipment and techniques (1 day)
- ◆ Practical firefighting (1½ day)
- ◆ Sea survival theory and practical drills (1 day)
- ◆ CBRNDC theory, organisation, communications, states and conditions, and incident board marking (½ day)
- ◆ CBRNDC hazards collective protection, individual protective equipment and CBRN cleansing procedures (½ day)
- ◆ Practical damage control (½ day)

EXAMINATIONS/QUALIFICATIONS GAINED

- ◆ MCA Certificate in 'Personal Survival Techniques' and 'Fire Prevention and Firefighting'

- ◆ Course includes practical drills in CBRN (in a CS gas environment), firefighting, damage control and sea survival
